

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air  
New Source Review Permit Number 180764**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Magellan Pipeline Company, L.P. (CN605367739) has submitted an application for initial permit number 180764. The Northwest Houston Terminal (RN110564093) will receive, store, and transfer gasoline, diesel, ethanol, and supplemental fuels at 25510 Zube Road, Hockley, Harris County.

This permit will authorize storage tanks and their associated piping, loading, and control equipment. Magellan Pipeline Terminals, L.P. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The new facilities will be controlled by floating roof tank design, submerged fill, vacuum loading, vapor recovery, vapor combustion, and physical inspection.
