Located at: 17707 Highway 36, Needville, Fort Bend County, Texas 77461

If you live within 440 yards (0.25 miles) of the facility, you are eligible to request a **Contested Case Hearing to oppose the renewal of this permit**. Contested Case Hearings are legal proceedings that allow individuals to present evidence in opposition to the permit application.

To submit a hearing request, go to <http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/epic/eComment/> and type "183358" in the Permit Number box. **The following information is required in your comment to be granted a Contested Case Hearing:**

1. Your name, mailing address, and daytime phone number

- If the request is made by a group or association, one or more members who have standing to request a hearing must be identified by name and address.

2. The permit applicant's name and registration number.

- AA Concrete Ready Mix, LLC, Permit 183358

3. Explicitly say, "I request a contested case hearing."

4. Your physical address

- Include your distance from the facility.
- Describe your use of the property at this address. Explain if you own, lease, rent, or have another interest in the property, such as work or recreation.

5. Explanation of how you are an "affected person." This explains how **you** will be negatively impacted by the facility in a way uncommon among the general public. These are the most important pieces of information to include:

- Negative health and safety impacts of the facility on you and your family, especially related to air quality.
 - *Example: Exposure to fine particulate matter may cause respiratory symptoms like coughing, wheezing, shortness of breath, and asthma attacks. It can exacerbate underlying health issues like asthma or COPD.*
- Negative impact on your use and enjoyment of your property.
 - *Example: Spending time outdoors on a nearby property may be more difficult or unappealing due to facility emissions and truck traffic.*
- Negative impact of air emissions on wildlife and the surrounding environment.
 - *Example: Air emissions may pose health impacts for wildlife, vegetation, and water quality in nearby parks, homes, and gardens.*
- Interests you hope to protect by requesting a Contested Case Hearing.
